NOMINATIONS FOR OUR SCHOOL LEADERSHIP TEAM

The very detailed process of students wishing to nominate for a position in the various leadership roles for 2019 has begun. Students who have expressed their interest in applying for a position must complete the Leadership Application and seek the referral of three teachers. A Student Leadership Committee consider all applications and the students’ behaviour in demonstrating the values of being safe, respectful and responsible, modelling this behaviour and their overall participation in being an active school citizen. Successful candidates then meet with 2 teachers for an interview where they discuss their reasons for wanting to be a leader; this is a casual conversation in preparation for the final stage of preparing and

presenting a speech to the student body, before the students vote.

We wish all students participating in this all the best. It is a courageous thing to do – nominating oneself, knowing that not all students will be successful due to the limited positions. This is a true reflection of citizenship – having a red hot go!
