ANAPHYLAXIS

Each year we have a growing number of students who are at risk of anaphylaxis. Anaphylaxis is the most severe form of allergic reaction and is potentially life threatening.

It must be treated as a medical emergency, requiring immediate treatment and urgent medical attention.

Milk, eggs, peanuts, tree nuts, sesame, fish, shellfish, wheat and soy are the most common food triggers, which cause 90 percent of allergic reactions; however, any food can trigger anaphylaxis.

To ensure we keep all of our students safe can you please talk to your children and **remind them of the importance of not sharing food.**

This year across NSW schools close to half of the incidents relating to anaphylaxis reported occurred as a result of students consuming food shared by other students that contained their allergen, at either school or while on a school excursion or camp.

We appreciate your support in keeping all of our students at Bateau Bay Public School safe.

SCHOOL HEALTH ISSUE – Season of sickness

Just a friendly reminder that we are heading into the 'season of sickness' where illness seems to become a little more prevalent as the colder weather sets upon us. We would like to remind parents that if your child is presenting with signs of illness that we would encourage you to provide care for them at home until they are well enough to return to school.

As much as we are a school that encourages sharing and caring between all members of our school community – ill health and sickness are not something we wish to be spreading throughout the school.

SCHOOL WEBSITE

Our Bateau Bay Public School website, www.bateaubay-p.schools.nsw.edu.au, contains a wide range of information about opportunities provided by our school. It is the main source of school information. Copies of notes and newsletters are available for download from the school website. The website also contains a calendar of school events with weekly overviews of school events provided in the 'news' section of the website.

SCHOOL NEWSLETTER

Our school newsletter is published fortnightly on a Friday. It provides information for our community about general school matters, school events, school and student achievements, P&C and canteen information as well as relevant community services and activities.

Parents can sign up to receive the newsletter by direct email to their email account as soon as the newsletter is published. Please contact our school office on 4332 8000 for details on how to sign up for this service.

SCHOOL NOTES

Information about class and school events, including permission notes, is sent as paper copies with students or emailed directly to parents email address. Copies are also available for download from the school website and 'skoolbag app'.

STAGE NEWSLETTERS

Each term, stage newsletters are published with overviews and information about class and stage programs. Stage newsletters can be downloaded from the school website.

SCHOOL SIGN

Our school sign is located on the corner of Marlowe Road & Waratah Street and contains details about upcoming school events.

SKOOLBAG APP

Our school uses the Skoolbag app to provide 'push' notifications about class, year and school information. Both 'Apple' and 'Android' versions of the app are available. Search your app provider for the 'Bateau Bay Public School Skoolbag App' to download our app to your device.

SCHOOL ASSEMBLIES

School Assemblies provide opportunities to celebrate student and school achievements as well as information about current matters.

School assemblies are held on Fridays at 12.50pm, Infants (Years K-2) are on even weeks and Primary (Years 3-6) are on odd weeks.

Special and whole school assemblies are held at times throughout the year. Details of all school assemblies are available in the calendar section of our school website.

CLASS DOJO

Some teachers may use the 'Class Dojo' App to distribute information about class programs. Class Dojo is used as a one way communication tool from the teacher to families. Families can not communicate to the teacher using this program.

P&C MEETINGS

A report on the school's directions and achievements is provided to the community by way of the Principal's report at the monthly P&C meetings. Meeting dates are published on our school website. All school matters raised at P&C will be referred back to the school for management.

PARENT INTERVIEWS

Staff are available for face to face or phone interviews by prior mutual arrangement.

INFORMATION MORNINGS

Stage information mornings are held at the beginning of each year and provide information for parents and families about class and stage programs.

Other information mornings are held throughout the year. Details are published on our school website and in our school newsletter.

STUDENT REPORTS

A written report about each child's progress and achievements in learning, social and behavioural outcomes is provided twice per year, at the end of Term 2 (Semester 1) and the end of Term 4 (Semester 2).

COMMUNITY CONSULTATION

The school seeks parent and community feedback and provides information about a wide range of matters through various informal and formal means including meetings, surveys and forums. Details of these opportunities are published in our school newsletter.

ANNUAL REPORT

The school provides a written Annual Report each year to inform our community about the school's achievements and future directions. The Annual Report is published on our school website.
