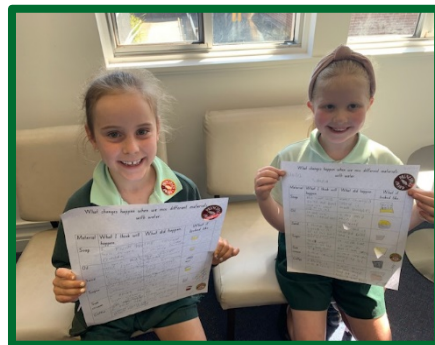

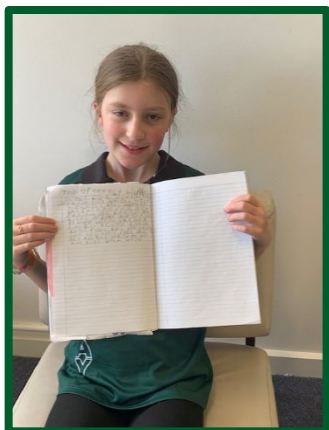

## PRINCIPAL REPORT

### Cyber Safety Presentation

On Wednesday 14 October (Week 1) our school will host the Police Youth Officer from the Tuggerah Lakes Area Command who will speak with Stage 3 students regarding appropriate use of digital devices and social media. We appreciate police support in keeping our students safe. Next term through the P&C we will be drafting school procedures in line with new Department of Education guidelines regarding mobile digital devices.

### Updated COVID Guidelines for Schools

Yesterday information was provided to families regarding updated advice on restrictions for schools moving into Term 4. Schools continue to be safe and operations are in line with AHPPC and NSW Health advice.

Parents are able to access the full document via the skoolbag app but important points are below.

#### What hasn't changed

- Parents and carers are reminded not to send children to school to if they are unwell, even if they have the mildest flu-like symptoms
- Students with flu-like symptoms need to be tested and provide a copy of a negative COVID-19 test result and be symptom free before being permitted to return to school.
- Schools continue to follow hygiene protocols for students including regular handwashing.
- Parents/carers are not allowed on the school site including for assemblies.
- Adults collecting children in the afternoon must remain 1.5m from each other at all times.

#### What's changed

- Interschool activities can now occur with a COVID-19 safety plan.
- Schools are now able to organise Year 6 Farewells in line with restrictions.
- Kindergarten Orientation can now commence. Please note specific information regarding our amended program will be sent to all families early in Term 4.

Further information will be provided in Term 4 regarding end of year school celebrations including presentation assemblies.

### Term 4

As this is the final newsletter for Term 3 I would like to once again thank the hardworking staff for their ongoing commitment to quality learning at Bateau Bay Public School. Term 3 has been extraordinarily challenging but as a school community supported by parents and carers we have continued to provide positive opportunities for our students.

A reminder there is no staff development day on the first day of Term 4.

I hope all families have a relaxing break and return refreshed, ready for a rewarding Term 4.

Curious Creatures, Wild Minds!



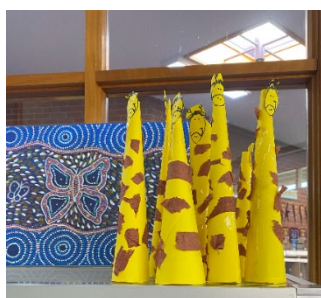
Bateau Bay Public School is celebrating Book Week this year in Term 4, Week 3.

## Intention to apply for Year 7 entry to a selective high school in 2022

Dear Parent/Carer

Selective high schools cater for highly achieving academically gifted students who may otherwise be without sufficient classmates at their own academic and social level. These schools help gifted and talented students to learn by grouping them with other gifted and talented students, teaching them in specialised ways and providing educational materials at the appropriate level.

Applications for selective high school placement are considered mainly on the basis of the Selective High School Placement Test results and school assessment scores. The Selective High School Placement Test will be held on **Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> March 2021**.

If you would like to have your child considered for Year 7 selective high school entry in 2022, you need to apply soon. You will need to apply on the internet using a valid email address (not the student's email address).

Detailed instructions on how to apply online will be available in late September 2020 at <https://education.nsw.gov.au/public-schools/selective-high-schools-and-opportunity-classes/year-7>.

The application website opens at that link on 6th October 2020 and closes on 9th November 2020. No late applications will be accepted.

There are no paper application forms. If you do not have internet access, you could apply at a public library. If you have a disability that prevents you from using a computer, you can contact the Unit for assistance after 6 October 2020.

You must submit only ONE application for each student.

**Remember: the slip attached is not an application and the school cannot apply on your behalf.**
