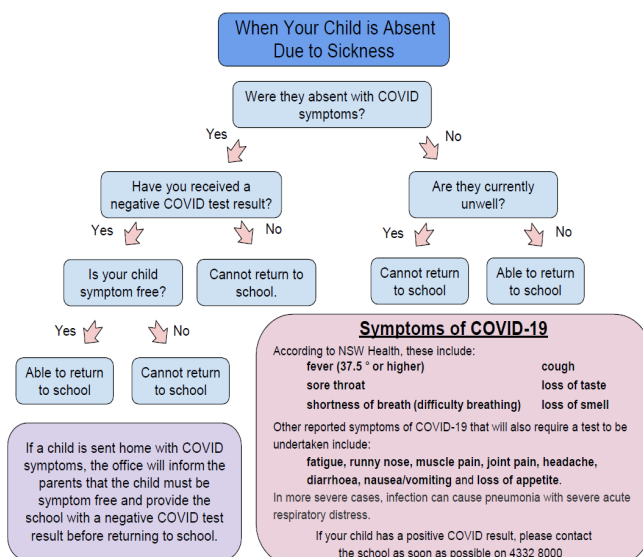

DEPUTY PRINCIPAL REPORT ATTENDANCE

If your child is sick it is the responsibility of the parent to contact the school and inform the school of the absence. This can be done via phone message, Skoolbag, email, responding to the SMS or a note brought in by your child to the class teacher. If no notification is received within 7 days the absence will be marked as an unjustified absence.



Please remember if your child has 3 or more days off in a row it is now a requirement of the Department of Education that a medical certificate be provided to explain the absence. If the school does not receive a medical certificate the absence will be marked as unjustified.

If a large number of unjustified absences are recorded against a child the school is required to follow up these absences. Which may include requesting parents attend an attendance improvement meeting at the school, or the involvement of the Home School Liaison Officer.

The Online Enrolment System is designed to provide flexibility for parents to submit an Enrolment Application online at a time that best suits you. The application can be accessed on all browsers and mobile devices including iOS and Android.

The online application process is currently restricted to:

- Enrolments into local schools only
- Children who are Australian citizens, New Zealand citizens or permanent residents
- Children who live in NSW.

We offer our support and encourage you to complete your application to enrol online. If however, you do not feel comfortable completing an application online, a paper copy will be available for collection from the front office or can be downloaded from the Department's going to a public school site.

Primary ETHICS

Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcoming a new member to the Primary Ethics team is John McAleer. John is a parent at the school and with all his training done, is able to teach the Primary Ethics program. John is teaching Stage 1 with the current topic Pride and some of the subsequent topics being Laziness, Forgiving and Being Forgiveness. John has found the students enthusiastic and engaging so far.

I am currently teaching stage 3 and am on the topic of Human Rights-Do Other Animals Have Them with subsequent topics to come being Fatalism and Moral Responsibility. I have found my students to be very thoughtful and open minded.

Due to demand for ethics classes across the school, we will require additional volunteers to be trained to facilitate the classes. Until volunteers are recruited, we cannot fulfil all the students requesting to participate in ethics. Currently there are 128 students not being taught throughout Early Stage 1, Stage 1, Stage 2 and Stage 3.

Suitable volunteers should have an interest in children's education, development of critical thinking skills and must be available at Thursday 11:30-12:10 each week.
